Kristyn Anderson's job is not to "defend the people", or "the council", or the law in any way, it is to preserve the perception of integrity of Mayor Frey's office, which is increasingly looking like perhaps the most corrupt administration in modern history, and she is actively involved in ACTIVE cases involving the other two individuals up for reappointment—Todd Barnette and Margaret Anderson Kelliher. It might be wise to rethink reappointing people at the center of a flurry of ongoing scandals and the very attorney defending them. Local media will have you believe that Mr. Frey is a simple victim of Federal attacks, when in reality—he is the center of over a handful of lawsuits that could topple the City of Minneapolis' credibility for the foreseeable future.

1. Case Number: 27-CV-26-1506. Anderson is defending City Clerk Casey Carl, and the City of Minneapolis vs. The Star Tribune in two lawsuits filed in as many months in what appears to be the most high profile case involving the willful suppression of data in order to protect Chief O'Hara and MPD in State history. The Strib is suing Carl and the City for allegedly suppressing "the name of every member of the public who has ever filed a complaint against Chief O'Hara". This data is held within The Office of Police Conduct Review and Office of Community Safety alongside other departments strictly under control of Kristyn Anderson and Mayor Frey thanks to the Strong-Mayor system.

Todd Barnette, who stacked the Charter Commission for Frey and in favor of the elite for years, is the current head of the Office of Community Safety and is up for reappointment today alongside two other individuals directly embroiled in ACTIVE lawsuits with merit. The only people that benefit from these reappointments are Jacob Frey, Casey Carl, Margaret Anderson Kelliher, Kristyn Anderson, Todd Barnette, and the host of fraudsters in Frey's inner circle who these individuals shield from prosecution and the ire of the Feds. It

might not be a great idea to reappointment people in the middle of massive public lawsuits alleging suppression while under the microscope of the Federal government.

2. Anderson oversees Heather Robertson, who is the active attorney for Jacob Frey in Case Number: 27-CV-26-3432 in Alberder Gillespie vs the City of Minneapolis and Mayor Jacob Frey for unlawful termination, which included spying, harassment, and trumped up charges conjured up by Margaret Anderson Kelliher in order to solve a problem for Frey. While disreputable local news propaganda like the Minneapolis Times, operated by Frey loyalist Tim Keane, claims that the oppression, mistreatment, and unthinkable treatment of Black female professionals at City Hall is a result of Council attacks, it's obvious that this is merely a distraction from the most important case at hand, which involves the incredibly disturbing acts of Jacob Frey, Margaret Anderson Kelliher, and the City Attorney's office. After appointment, Miss Kelliher wasted no time fabricating childlike accusations against Ms. Gillespie in order to justify her firing, proving her loyalty and keep to the Frey administration—who, frankly, everyone should be running away from right now. The pain and suffering endured by Ms. Gillespie should be a massive warning that this inner circle of elites will stop at nothing to protect Jacob Frey and their own careers.

3. A host of Federal lawsuits going nowhere and act as as smokescreen to distract the public from the actions of these people and create the perception that they are defenders of the people, when in reality the combination of Frey, Kelliher, Anderson, and Barnette, is a recipe for catastrophic damage to this City, which will destroy the credibility of our City, tanking credit ratings, hobbling debt-issuance abilities, and sending us down a wormhole of awful consequences.

Anyone who speaks out publicly against these appointments can kiss their own life goodbye
