Authorizing acceptance of Project Orders from the Minnesota Public Facilities Authority for lead service line replacement projects.

Whereas, the City of Minneapolis has entered into Lead Service Line Replacement Program Master Grant Agreement Minneapolis_LSLR_00 with the Minnesota Public Facilities Authority; and

Whereas, that Master Agreement requires the City of Minneapolis to accept specific Project Orders and authorize the execution and delivery of such orders; and

Whereas, the City of Minneapolis has three Lead Service Line Replacement Projects included on the 2026 Intended Use Plan (IUP) as follows:

- \$13,125,177 for replacement of LSLs in the Northside Green Zone (IUP Project 12700024-20),
- \$5,102,267 for replacement of LSLs associated with street renewal projects and at licensed daycares (IUP Project 1270024- 16), and
- \$3,141,788 for replacement of leaking LSLs over two years (IUP Project 1270024-25).

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by The City Council of The City of Minneapolis:

That the City of Minneapolis has the legal authority to accept each 2026 project order.

Be it further resolved that proper city officers shall execute and fully deliver each project order as specified.
