Pursuant to City Charter Section 7.1(h)(2), the Minneapolis City Council, in support of its official legislative, policymaking, and oversight functions, does hereby request from the Mayor the following information and data:

1. Overview of work undertaken with regard to the actions proposed by the Administration in 2022 to increase access to Gender-Neutral Restrooms. Include an update on ongoing or past efforts to:
 1. Remind buildings of the State building code prohibition on gender restrictions on single-stall bathrooms.
 2. Enforce compliance with the State building code prohibition on gender restrictions on single-stall bathrooms in new and renovated buildings, including any complaints process through 311.
 3. Incentivize pre-2020 buildings to comply with the State building code prohibition.

4. Purchase gender-neutral signs that buildings can request online to put on single-stall restrooms (or otherwise).
 5. Encourage gender-neutral bathrooms through social media and by including notices in mailings (for example utility billing or licensing mailing).
 6. Include handouts on gender-neutral bathrooms at annual inspections for food service businesses.
2. Overview of any other actions taken to incentivize property owners to add gender-neutral bathrooms.
 3. Information on how other cities have encouraged or incentivized public serving buildings to make single-stall restrooms gender-neutral (with signage).
 4. Information on additional potential forward-looking steps that might increase the availability of gender-neutral restrooms.

The requested information and data are requested to be presented, along with a fiscal analysis of any recommendations, to the City Council through the Public Health, Safety & Equity Committee on August 27, 2026.
