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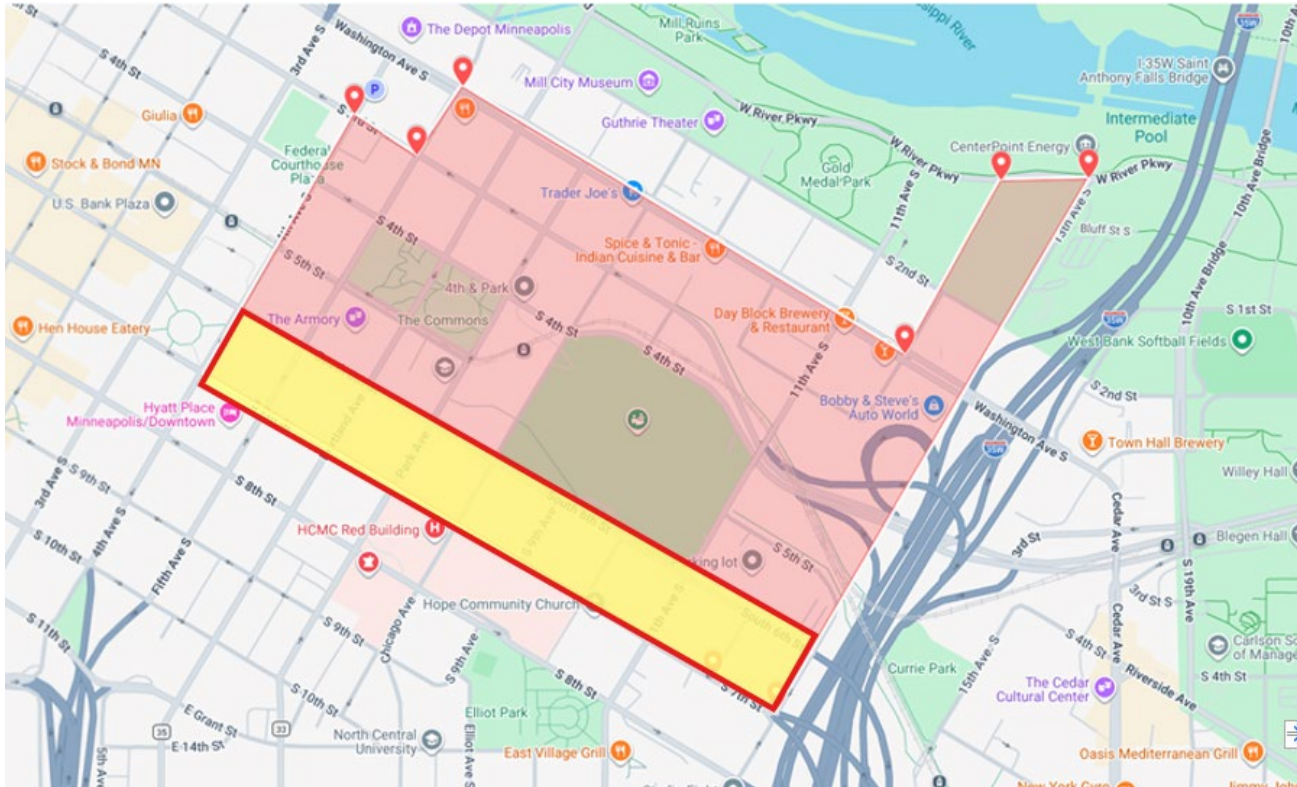
Tailgating in Open Air Motor Vehicle Parking Lots

- A tailgate zone was first established in 1982 for Class A parking lots surrounding the Metrodome and was updated in 2016 with the construction of US Bank Stadium.
- Class A parking lots within the current tailgate zone (pictured) allow;
 - **Alcohol consumption** (but not sale of) on licensed parking lots beginning six hours before and ending three hours after a US Bank Stadium event.
 - **Food preparation by patrons** for their own consumption.
 - Tailgaters are **required to clean up** litter and debris generated by their activities.





Ordinance Changes



- Amend the ordinance to expand the current tailgate zone one block to the southeast along South 7th Street, from 4th Avenue South to 13th Avenue South (as pictured).
- The intent is to include parking lots (3) located immediately adjacent to the existing tailgate zone to be consistent with licensed parking lots in proximity to US Bank Stadium.
