

ORDINANCE

Amending Title 14, Chapter 360 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances relating to Liquor and Beer: In General.

The City Council of the City of Minneapolis do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 360 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances be amended by adding thereto a new Section 360.230 to read as follows:

360.230. Posting of Dress Code Required. (a) If a person operating a premises licensed under this chapter requires a dress code for entry to said premises, the complete dress code shall be posted in a conspicuous place at or near the entrance to the premises so that it may be easily viewed by the public during the premises' hours of operation.

(b) If a premises does not have a dress code policy displayed conspicuously near the entrance, it shall be interpreted that there is no dress code, and no dress code policy may be enforced.

(c) For purposes of this section, "dress code" means a set standard of rules specifying the required manner of dress with which an attendee must comply for entry.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective January 1, 2027.
