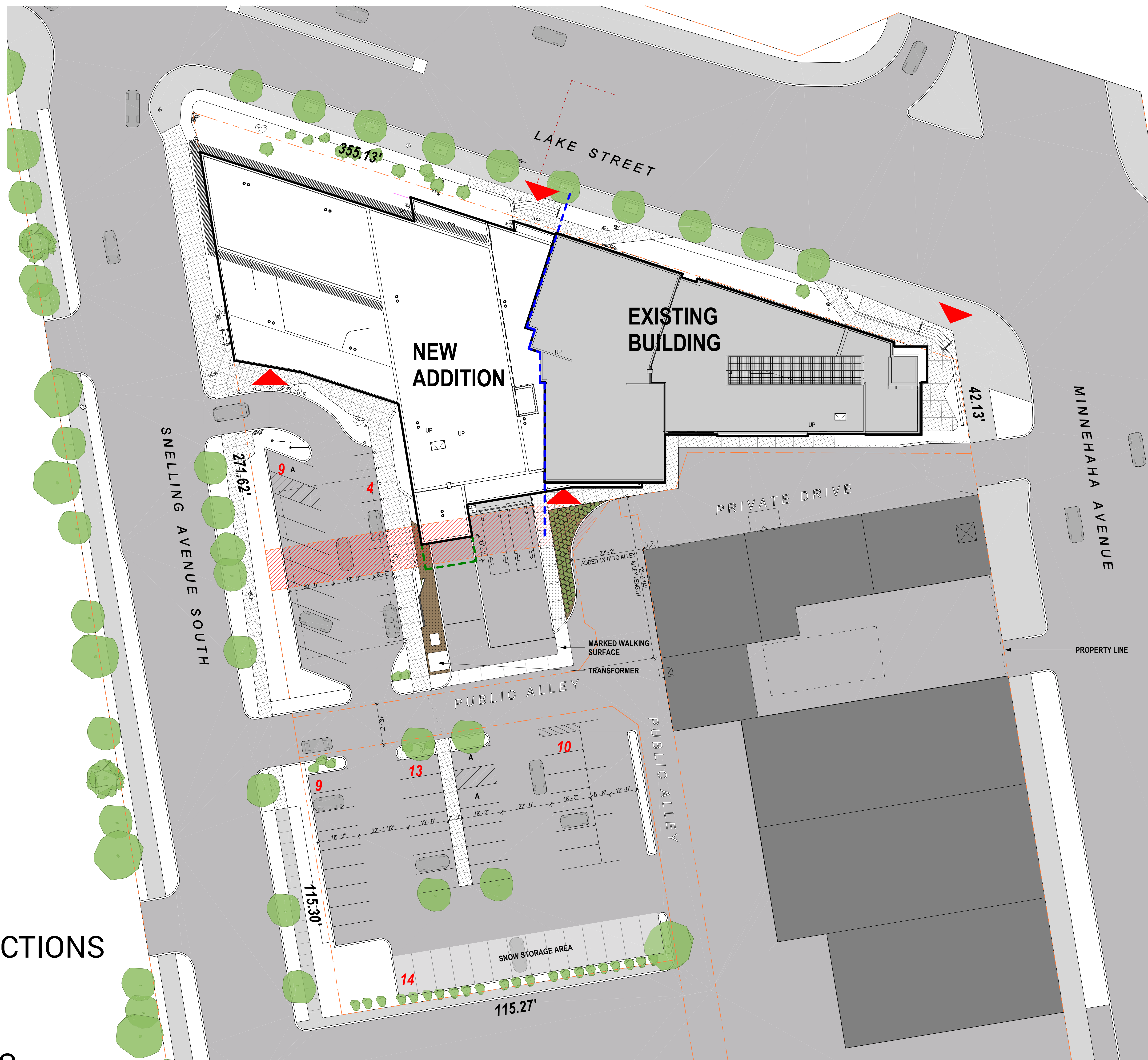

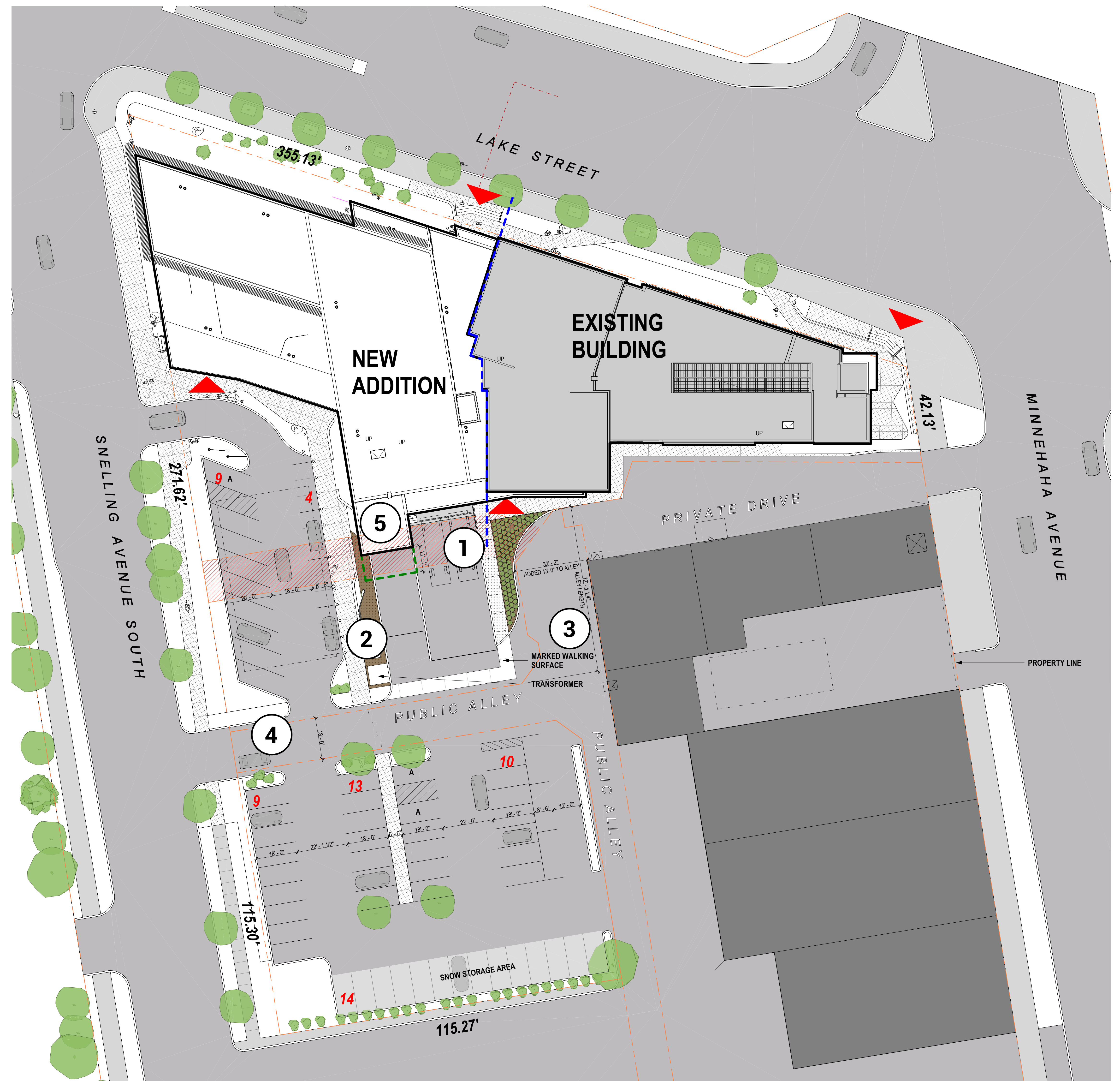


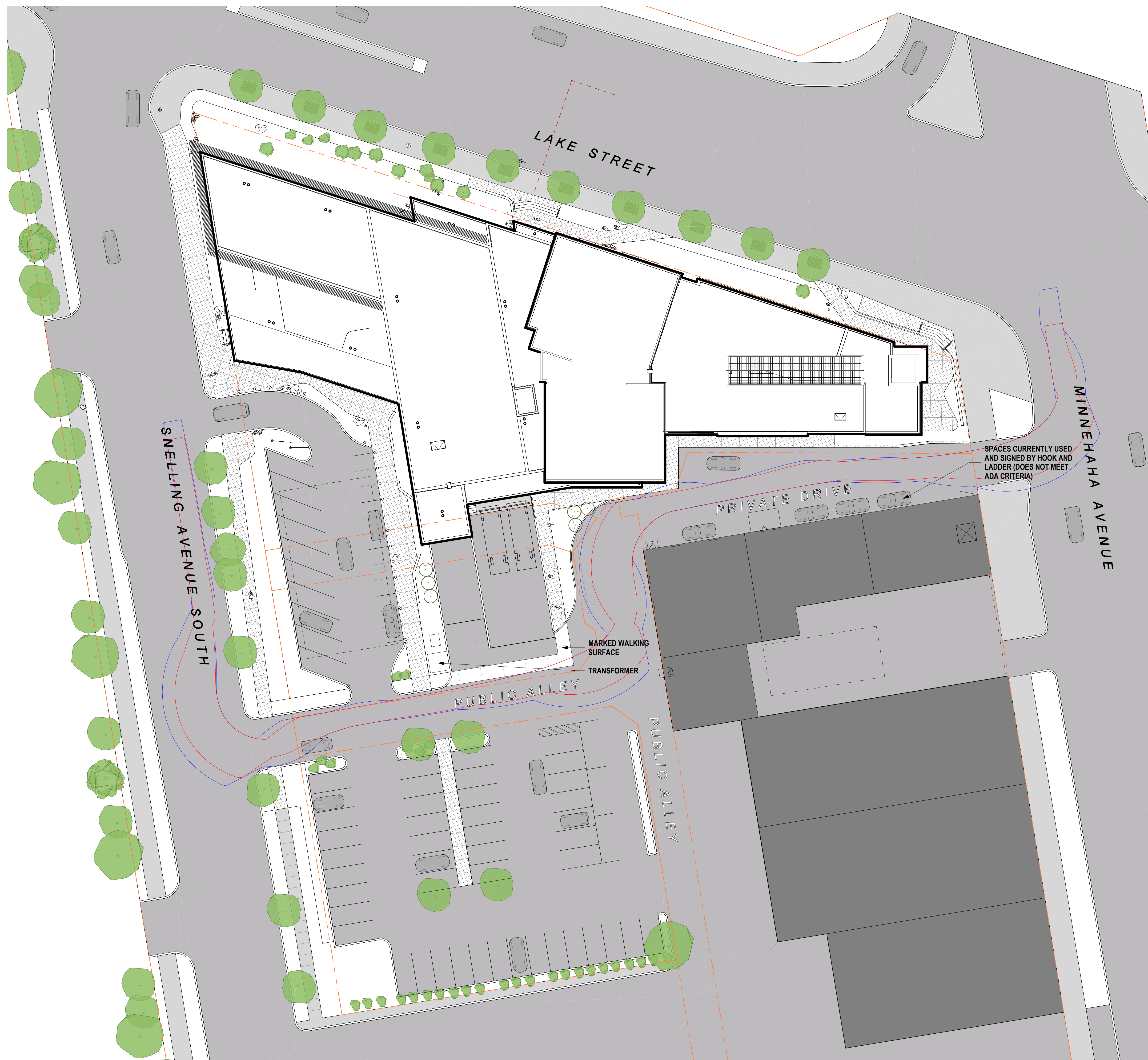


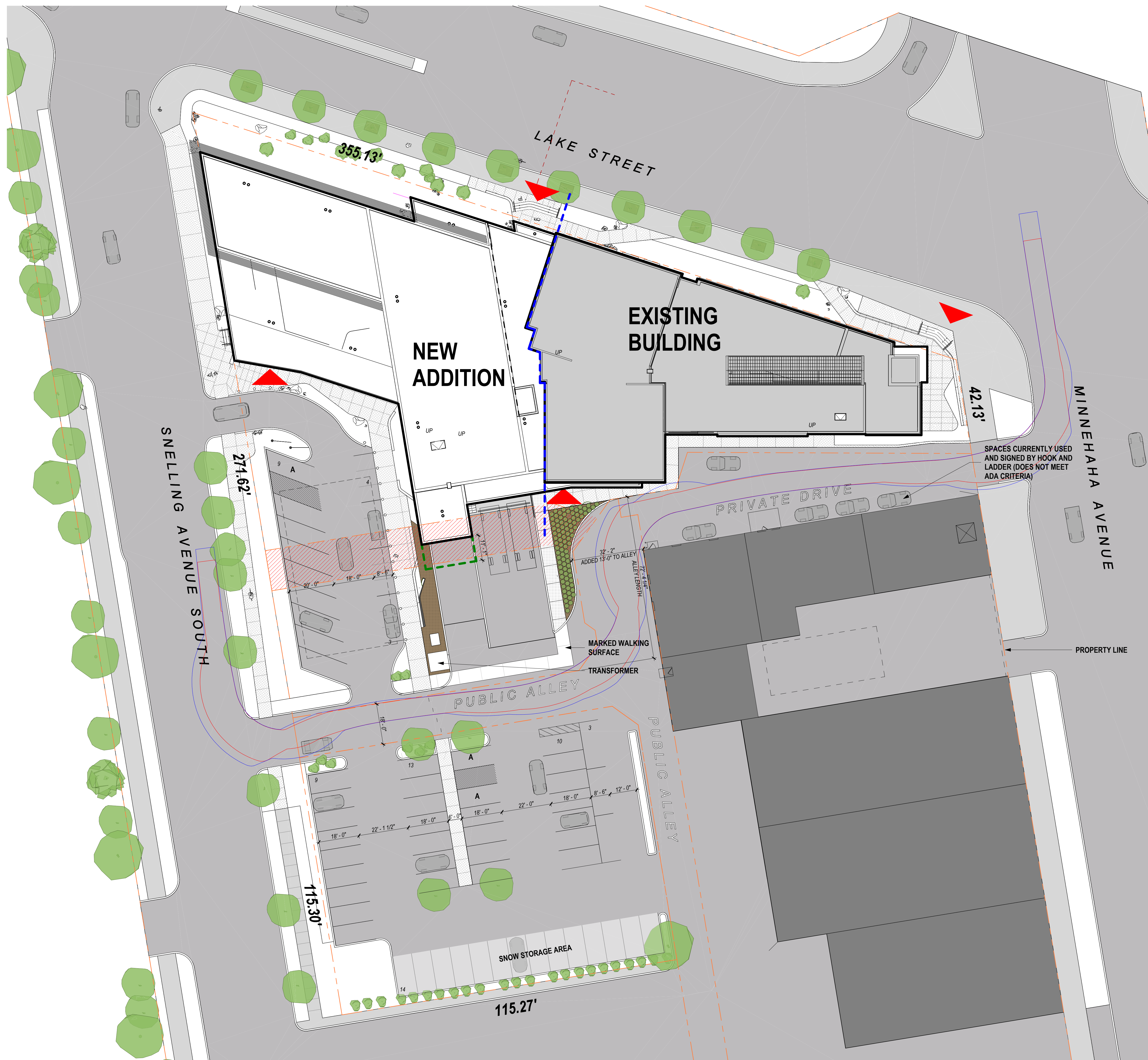
PARKING COUNT

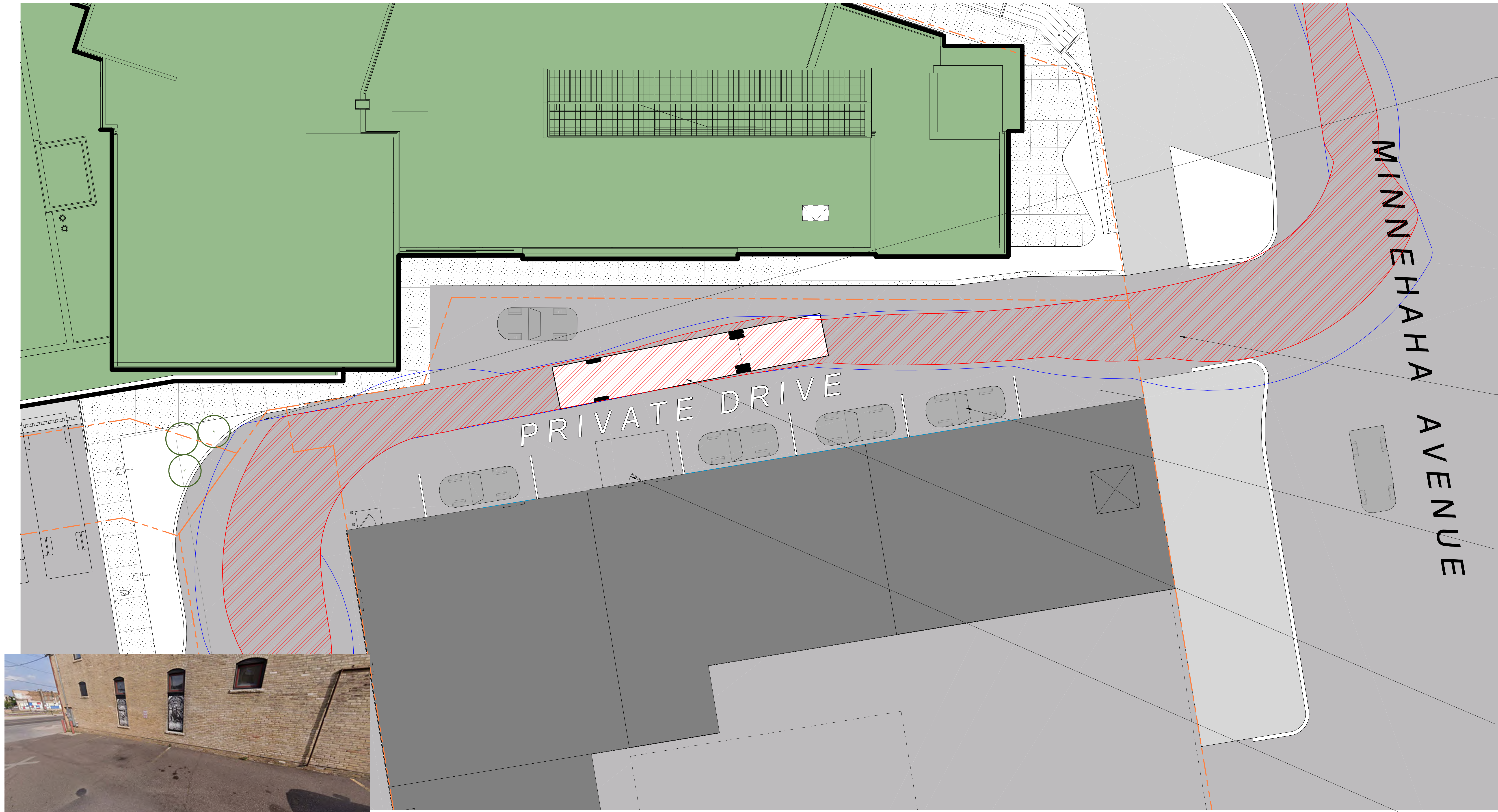

- 4 Added a concrete sidewalk from Snelling
- 5 Shifted the Garage further north into the facility.

TURNING RADIUS DOES NOT CHANGE UNTIL THE TRUCK IS PAST THE PARKED VEHICLES ON THE SIMULATION.

***PARKING SPOTS SIGNED BY HOOK AND LADDER DO NOT MEET THE CRITERIA OF ACCESSIBLE PARKING.**

THE RED AND BLUE LINES INDICATE THE EXTENT OF THE VEHICULAR TURNING SIMULATION AS MODELED BY THE CIVIL ENGINEER, RED BEING THE EXTENT OF THE WHEELS, BLUE BEING THE EXTEND OF THE VEHICLE BODY.
