This Agreement is between the City of St. Paul, a municipal corporation ("City") and Ramsey County, a political subdivision of the State of Minnesota, ("County")

WHEREAS, The Project Limits are defined as Larpenteur Avenue (County State Aid Highway 30) from Flandrau Street to Hazel Street ("Project Limits"); and

WHEREAS, in the area affected by construction, Larpenteur Avenue is designated County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 30, and is located in the City; and

WHEREAS, Larpenteur Avenue is in City rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Project has been designated for funding by the Minnesota Department of Transportation ("MnDOT") as eligible for County State Aid Highway ("CSAH") funds, and, Municipal State Aid System ("MSAS") funds; and

WHEREAS, the Project has been designated as County State Aid Project (S.A.P.) 062-630-074 (Larpenteur Avenue) and Municipal State Aid Project 164-020-159 (Larpenteur Avenue); and

WHEREAS, the City and County desire to reconstruct Larpenteur Avenue between Flandrau Street to Hazel Street within the Project Limits ("Project") and this location is shown in Exhibit A – Project Location Map; and

WHEREAS, the reconstruction is identified in Ramsey County's 2023-2027 Transportation Improvement Program for Roadway Construction Improvements

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MUTUALLY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

AGREEMENT

1. Responsibility for Design Engineering

- 1.1. Plans, specifications, and proposals will be prepared in accordance with Mn/DOT State Aid requirements.
- 1.2. The County will prepare plans, specifications, and proposals for the Project, which will include, among other things, the proposed reconstruction, alignment, profiles, grades, cross sections, paving, concrete curb and gutter, medians, storm sewer, storm water treatment and infiltration basins, pedestrian curb ramps, turf establishment, traffic signals, accessible pedestrian signals, and utility replacement and adjustments.
- 1.3. Plans for the Project showing proposed construction will be presented to the City and will be on file at Ramsey County Public Works Department.
- 1.4. Any costs associated with Project revisions after the completion of plans and specifications will be paid for by the party requesting the revisions, with the exception of any costs associated with the Joint Storm Interceptor, as shown in Exhibit C – Storm Sewer Ownership. Costs associated with the Joint Storm Interceptor will be shared in equal one-third proportions between Ramsey County, the City of Maplewood, and the City of St. Paul, as outlined in Exhibit D – County Board File No. 1740. Revisions are subject to approval by all parties.

2. Responsibility for the Right of Way Plan and Acquisition

- 2.1. Right-of-Way being acquired for the Project is detailed in County Agreement PUBW2022-14R.

3. Procurement and Award of Contract

- 3.1. The County will take bids in accordance with state law and County procedures.
- 3.2. The County will prepare an abstract of bids and a cost participation summary based on the lowest responsible bidder's proposal and will provide the same to the City.
- 3.3. The County will require the City's concurrence to award a contract to the lowest responsible bidder.

4. Responsibility for Construction Engineering

4.1. The County shall perform or contract the performance of the construction engineering for all elements of the Project.

5. Project Costs

5.1. Except as provided herein, the County and City will participate in the costs of construction in accordance with the Ramsey County Cost Participation Policy as approved in the 2023 – 2027 Ramsey County Transportation Improvement Plan. If there is a conflict between the Cost Participation Policy and this Agreement, this Agreement shall prevail.

5.2. County and City will each be responsible for the total estimated cost of the construction pay items as shown in Exhibit B – Engineer’s Estimate. Quantities and unit prices shown in Exhibit B are estimates. Actual costs shall be based on the contract unit prices and the quantities constructed, determined after Project completion.

5.3. Mobilization, Field Office Type D - Modified, Remove Trench Drain, Traffic Control, Alternative Pedestrian Route, Stabilized Construction Exit, and Erosion Control Supervisor are defined collectively as the “Prorated Items” The City percentage of the Prorated Items is calculated as follows:

$$\text{City \% Prorated Items} = \frac{\text{(City Cost excluding the Prorated Items Cost)}}{\text{(Total Project Cost excluding the Prorated Items Cost)}}$$

The costs in the Prorated Items calculation will be based on contract unit prices and quantities at the time of contract award. No adjustments in the percentages will be made if unit prices or quantities vary during construction.

5.4. Costs associated with the Joint Storm Interceptor, as shown in Exhibit C – Storm Sewer Ownership, will be shared in equal one-third proportions between Ramsey County, the City of Maplewood, and the City of St. Paul. These costs are shown in Exhibit B – Engineer’s Estimate. Actual costs shall be based on the contract unit prices and the quantities constructed, determined after Project completion.

5.5. Design Engineering Costs

5.5.1. The City shall pay the County a design engineering fee equal to 12% of the City’s share of the construction pay items identified in Exhibit B.

5.6. Construction Engineering Costs

5.6.1. The City shall pay the County a construction engineering fee equal to 12% of the City's share of the construction pay items identified in Exhibit B.

6. Payment Schedule

6.1. The County will invoice design engineering fees at the time of contract award.

6.2. The County will invoice construction engineering costs monthly and at the time of substantial Project completion, as determined by the County.

6.3. The County will invoice construction costs monthly and at the time of substantial Project completion, based on the payments made to the contractor.

6.4. Invoices must include documentation of the charges, fees, and costs as reasonably required by the other party.

6.5. Payment will be made within 35 days of receipt of an invoice.

7. Ownership and Maintenance Responsibility for Project Elements

7.1. The joint powers agreement between the County and the City, County Resolution 93-643 and City Council File 93-1974, details maintenance responsibilities and costs on the County road system in the City.

7.2. The responsibility for the maintenance and repair of the Joint Sewer Interceptor shown in Exhibit C – Storm Sewer Ownership shall be shared in equal one-third proportions between Ramsey County, the City of Maplewood, and the City of St. Paul, as outlined in Exhibit D – County Board File No. 1740

8. The City grants the County temporary construction easements over all City owned right-of-way and property within the limits of the Project for use during construction at no cost to the County.

9. Each party is responsible for its own acts and omissions and the results thereof to the extent authorized by law and will not be responsible for the acts and omissions of any others and the results thereof.

10. The City and County shall indemnify, defend, and hold each other harmless against any and all liability, losses, costs, damages, expenses, claims, or actions, including attorney's fees, which the indemnified party, its officials, agents, or employees may hereafter sustain, incur, or be required to pay, arising out of or by reason of any act or omission of the indemnifying party, its officials, agents, or employees, in the execution, performance, or failure to adequately perform the indemnifying party's obligation pursuant to this Agreement. Nothing in this Agreement shall constitute a waiver by the County or the City of any statutory or common law immunities, limits, or exceptions on liability.

11. COUNTERPARTS: The parties may sign this Agreement in counterparts, each of which constitutes an original, but all of which together constitute one instrument.

12. ELECTRONIC SIGNATURES: The parties agree that the electronic signature of a party to this Agreement shall be as valid as an original signature of such party and shall be effective to bind such party to this Agreement. The parties further agree that any document (including this Agreement and any attachments or exhibits to this Agreement) containing, or to which there is affixed, an electronic signature shall be deemed (i) to be "written" or "in writing", (ii) to have been signed and (iii) to constitute a record established and maintained in the ordinary course of business and an original written record when printed from electronic files. For purposes hereof, "electronic signature" also means a manually signed original signature that is then transmitted by any electronic means, including without limitation a faxed version of an original signature or an electronically scanned and transmitted version (e.g., via PDF) of an original signature. Any party's failure to produce the original signature of any electronically transmitted signature shall not affect the enforceability of this Agreement.

13. This Agreement shall remain in full force and effect until terminated by mutual agreement of the parties.

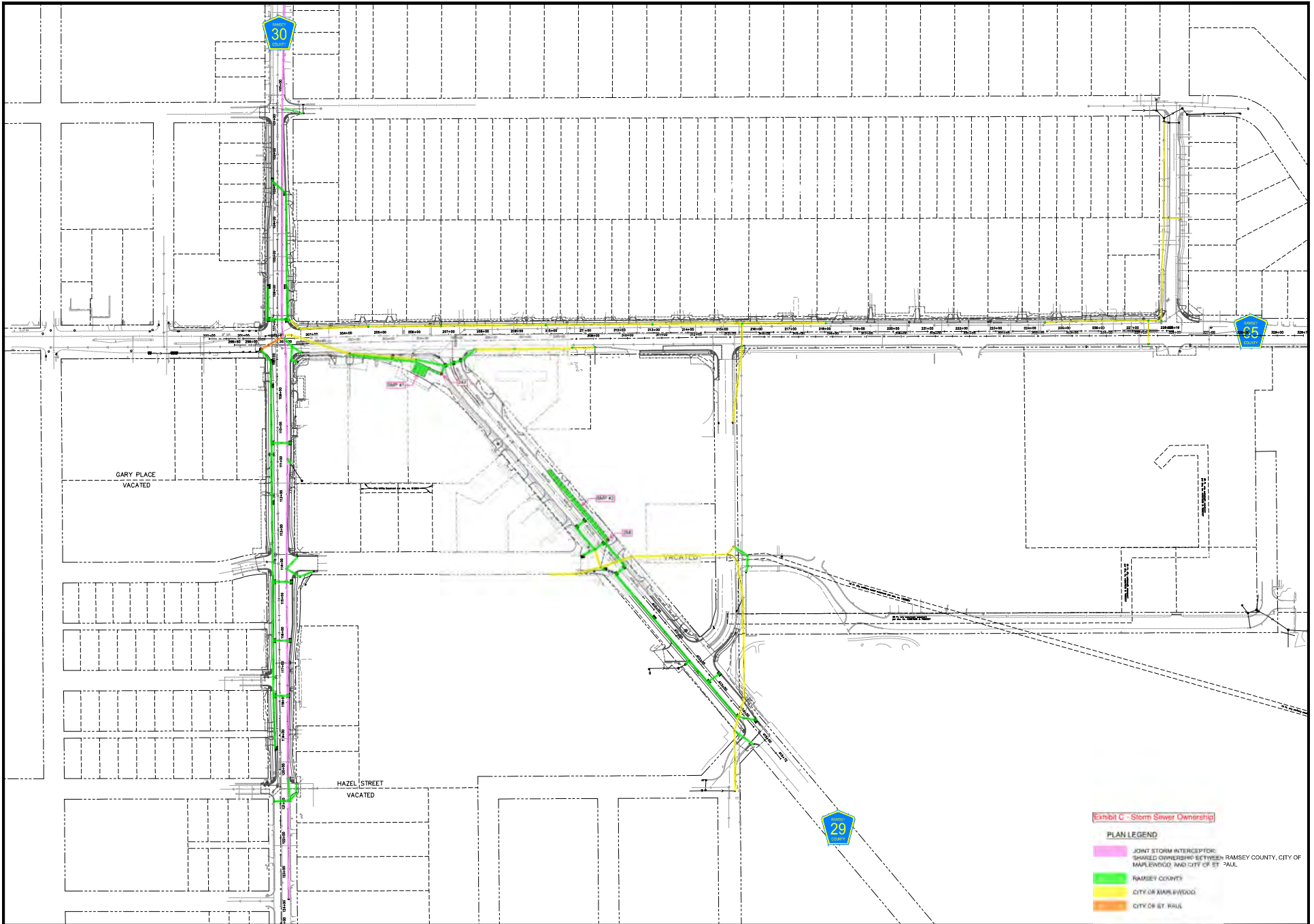

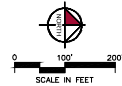
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- Exhibit C - Storm Sewer Ownership**

RESOLVED, By the Board of Ramsey County Commissioners, that a joint agreement between the City of Saint Paul, the Village of Maplewood and the County of Ramsey, providing for the design, construction, operation and maintenance of certain storm water sewer facilities to provide for the drainage of storm and surface waters from areas controlled by the City of Saint Paul, the Village of Maplewood and the County of Ramsey, lying generally in the vicinity of the intersection of White Bear Avenue and Larpenteur Avenue, which agreement at page 9 carries a revision date of March 10, 1967, a copy of which is hereto attached and incorporated herein by reference as fully and as completely as if set forth herein verbatim, be and is hereby in all things approved and the proper County officers are hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of Ramsey; be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the aforementioned agreement of March 10, 1967, shall be substituted in lieu and in place of the prior agreement between the City of Saint Paul, the Village of Maplewood and the County of Ramsey heretofore authorized by resolution of the County Board File 1740, Resolution 9-8406, adopted October 10, 1966, and the authority contained therein is cancelled and superseded hereby.

JOINT AGREEMENT
CITY OF SAINT PAUL - VILLAGE OF MAPLEWOOD - COUNTY OF RAMSEY

This instrument of agreement made and entered into jointly by the City of Saint Paul, acting by and through its council, and the Village of Maplewood, acting by and through its council, and the County of Ramsey, acting by and through its Board of County Commissioners, all pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 471.59,

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, The Parties hereto desire to enter into a joint agreement and effort providing generally for the design, construction, operation and maintenance of certain cooperative storm sewers to provide for the drainage of storm water and surface water from areas controlled by the Village of Maplewood and the City of Saint Paul in the County of Ramsey and affecting large areas owned, operated and controlled by the County of Ramsey, and

WHEREAS, The area involved in this proposed activity lies generally in the vicinity of the intersection of White Bear Avenue and Larpenteur Avenue, more fully indicated on attached Exhibit No. 1, and includes an area controlled and operated by Ramsey County as and for the County Home and recreational areas, and

WHEREAS, Preliminary feasibility studies and reports which have heretofore been conducted by the Engineering Departments of the City of Saint Paul, the Village of Maplewood and the County of Ramsey indicate that it is feasible, practical and technically proper to provide for the drainage of the storm and surface waters from the area above described into Wakefield Lake located generally at the intersection of Larpenteur Avenue and Prosperity Road in the Village of Maplewood, and by means of lake level control

structures to control the level of Wakefield Lake and outlet Wakefield Lake through a storm drainage sewer to the West along Larpenteur Avenue and outletting into Lake Phalen, and

WHEREAS, The surface water congestion and impounding presently existing in the area is of such nature as to require the immediate and urgent action of the governing bodies concerned in order to alleviate the condition, and

WHEREAS, The Parties to this agreement are in agreement with reference to the details hereinafter set forth;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AGREED by the Parties hereto, and each of them, as follows:

1. The engineering, planning and preparation of working drawings for the project will be undertaken and completed by the Engineering Department of the City of Saint Paul with the cooperation of the Engineer for the Village of Maplewood and the Engineer for the County of Ramsey. The Engineering Department will prepare detailed plans and specifications for the construction of a storm and surface water drainage project running generally from the area of Ruth Street in the Village of Maplewood into Wakefield Lake; providing for an outfall water level control structure from Wakefield Lake and a sewer running generally westerly along Larpenteur Avenue from Wakefield Lake to Lake Phalen and there outletting. The design criteria shall be that usually and normally accepted by the City of Saint Paul for the construction of its storm and surface water drainage projects.

2. Upon completion of the plans and specifications by the Engineering Department of the City of Saint Paul, these shall be submitted to the governing bodies of the City of Saint Paul, the County of Ramsey, and the Village of Maplewood for approval.

3. The plans and specifications for the project shall be divided into two phases of construction. Phase I shall include that portion of the project involving the overflow and control structure from Wakefield Lake and the storm drainage sewer running from Wakefield Lake westerly along Larpenteur Avenue and outletting into Lake Phalen. Phase I sewers are shown in broken line on Exhibit No. 1 which is attached hereto and made a part of this Agreement.

Phase II of the project shall include the plans and specifications for the construction of that portion of the project draining the area involved, in the vicinity of the intersection of White Bear Avenue and Larpenteur Avenue, into Wakefield Lake. Phase II sewers are as follows: In Larpenteur Avenue from approximately 400 feet east of Ruth Street to Wakefield Lake; in White Bear Avenue from California Avenue to Larpenteur Avenue; and in Van Dyke Street from Ripley Avenue to Larpenteur Avenue.

Plans and specifications, together with cost estimates, will be prepared separately for each of the above phases. Phase II sewers are shown in solid line on Exhibit No. 1.

4. When the plans and specifications for each of the phases have been approved by the governing bodies of the City of Saint Paul, the County of Ramsey and the Village of Maplewood, the Village of Maplewood will immediately advertise for construction bids for the construction of Phase I of the project, and will proceed in accordance with the statutes controlling the construction of internal improvements in the award of contract and construction of Phase I of the project. The entire supervision, control and operation of the construction project contemplated pursuant to Phase I of the project will be undertaken under the immediate supervision of the Village of Maplewood and the Village

Engineer. Upon award of contract for this construction the County of Ramsey will pay to the Village of Maplewood, as and for its share of the construction cost of Phase I the sum of \$100,000.00. The City of Saint Paul will at the same time pay to the Village of Maplewood the sum of \$5,000.00 as and for its share of the construction cost of Phase I of the project. The Village of Maplewood will provide the sum of \$200,000.00 as and for its share of the construction cost involved in the construction of Phase I. Payments shall be made to the Treasurer of the Village of Maplewood to be applied to the construction cost, and both of said payments may be treated by Maplewood as assessments for improvements to which the County and the City hereby agree.

5. It is contemplated by the Parties to this agreement that legislation will be submitted for consideration to the 1967 session of the Minnesota Legislature for authority to construct Phase II of this project in accordance with the terms of this agreement. Upon such legislation being adopted, and subject in all things to the action of the Legislature relating thereto, the County of Ramsey, upon and pursuant to legislative authority if granted, will advertise for bids and award construction contracts for the construction of Phase II of the project, in accordance with the plans and specifications theretofore adopted. The County of Ramsey shall act in the matter pursuant to statutes controlling generally contracts for public improvements within the County of Ramsey. Upon award of the contract therefor the City of Saint Paul will pay to the County of Ramsey the sum of \$245,000.00 as and for its share of the construction cost involved in the construction of Phase II, and the Village of Maplewood will pay to the County of Ramsey as and for its share of the construction cost thereof the sum of \$50,000.00. These payments shall be made

to the Treasurer of the County of Ramsey at the time aforesaid. The County of Ramsey will provide the sum of \$150,000.00 as and for its share of the construction cost involved in the construction of Phase II.

6. It is the estimate of the Parties hereto that the total cost of construction of the two phases of the project as outlined above will be approximately \$305,000.00 for Phase I and \$445,000.00 for the construction of Phase II. Where total cost of construction or construction cost is mentioned in this agreement, it shall mean total project cost, including contractor's cost, engineering and inspection, legal fees, easement costs, laboratory materials, tests and other direct contract costs. In the event that the construction cost as finally determined by contract awarded in the construction of either phase differs from this proposed estimate, the difference shall be paid by the Parties hereto in the same proportion as is indicated in this agreement with reference to the payment of the estimated cost of such phase. Repayments of excess moneys will be made in the same proportion. After completion of both phases, final adjustment will be made upon a certification of the various amounts due under this agreement by the Auditor of Ramsey County to the Parties hereto so that each party shall pay equal one-third shares of the total cost of Phase I and Phase II of the project.

7. Change Orders in the plans and specifications in an amount not to exceed \$2,000.00 may be approved by the Engineer in charge of the project for either the Village of Maplewood in Phase I or the County of Ramsey in Phase II. Change Orders in excess of \$2,000.00 must be presented to the governing bodies prior to approval for consideration and action.

8. Any legal services involved in the acquisition of right-of-way, preparation of contract documents or other legal work

involved in the project shall be provided by the attorney for the Village of Maplewood as concerns Phase I and by the County Attorney of the County of Ramsey as concerns Phase II of this project.

9. Upon completion of the project the operation and maintenance and control of the work accomplished under Phase I shall be the sole and exclusive responsibility of the Village of Maplewood, except for maintenance of the overflow structure, which shall be the responsibility of the County. Insofar as Phase II is concerned, the operation and maintenance and control of the work shall be the sole and exclusive responsibility of the City of Saint Paul, except for the Van Dyke Street portion in the Village of Maplewood, which shall be the responsibility of the Village of Maplewood. Any expense incurred in the maintenance or repair of the main sewers constructed under both Phase I and Phase II of the project, as shown on Exhibit No. 1, shall be borne by the Parties to this agreement in equal one-third proportionate shares, except for the routine maintenance of the overflow structure, the costs of which shall be borne by Ramsey County exclusively. Payment shall be made among the Parties from time to time as necessary upon certification of the Ramsey County Auditor to the various governing bodies concerned.

The City of Saint Paul shall be responsible for the cost of construction and maintenance of all catch basins and leads constructed under the provisions of Section 10 and built within the City of Saint Paul, exclusive of those built in Larpenteur Avenue. The Village of Maplewood shall be responsible for the cost of construction and maintenance of all catch basins built pursuant to the provisions of Section 10 and located within the Village of Maplewood, exclusive of those located in Larpenteur Avenue. The County of Ramsey shall be responsible for the cost

of construction and maintenance of those catch basins and leads built in Larpentour Avenue under Phase I of the project and shall be responsible for the maintenance of those catch basins and leads built in Larpontour Avenue under Phaso II of the project.

10. The agreement is intended to define cost shares for the sewer trunk line that is to be used to carry runoff from the County of Ramsey, the Village of Maplewood and the City of Saint Paul. It is not the intention of this agreement to share costs of catch basins and leads that connect the catch basins to the cooperative main line sewer, except as described in Section 11. The County may advertise for and accept bids and award contracts for construction of catch basins and pipe connections to the jointly-financed sewers described in Section 3 and indicated on Exhibit No. 1 if such sewer appurtenances are requested either by the County of Ramsey, the City of Saint Paul or the Village of Maplewood and provision for payment of the cost of such sewer appurtenances is made by the responsible municipality. The County may provide for the concurrent construction of such appurtenances hereunder if, at the time of advertising for bids, the municipality involved has provided for the payment of any costs or charges attributable thereto. Such contracts shall be a separate item on any bid or proposal.

11. It also is hereby agreed that the County of Ramsey will reconstruct and repave Larpentour Avenue within the limits of the Phase II sewer project. It is anticipated that the Larpentour Avenue reconstruction will be accomplished with the Phase II sewer work under a single contract. It is also understood and agreed that the costs for repaving of Larpentour Avenue shall include costs of drainage structures including catch basins in

Larpenteur Avenue and leads therefrom. It is further agreed that the City of Saint Paul and the Village of Maplewood will participate in the costs of the Larpenteur Avenue repaving project in accordance with the following formula: The costs of repaving of Larpenteur Avenue to a width needed to accommodate future traffic requirements for the design life of the pavement will be the total cost responsibility of the County of Ramsey. The cost of parking widths or additional traffic lanes requested by the City of Saint Paul and the Village of Maplewood shall be shared twenty-five per cent by the County of Ramsey and seventy-five per cent by the Village of Maplewood or by the City of Saint Paul depending on the side that the pavement is widened. All costs of catch basins and leads constructed on Larpenteur Avenue within the limits of the Phase II sewer project shall be distributed uniformly across the total pavement width before computing cost shares.

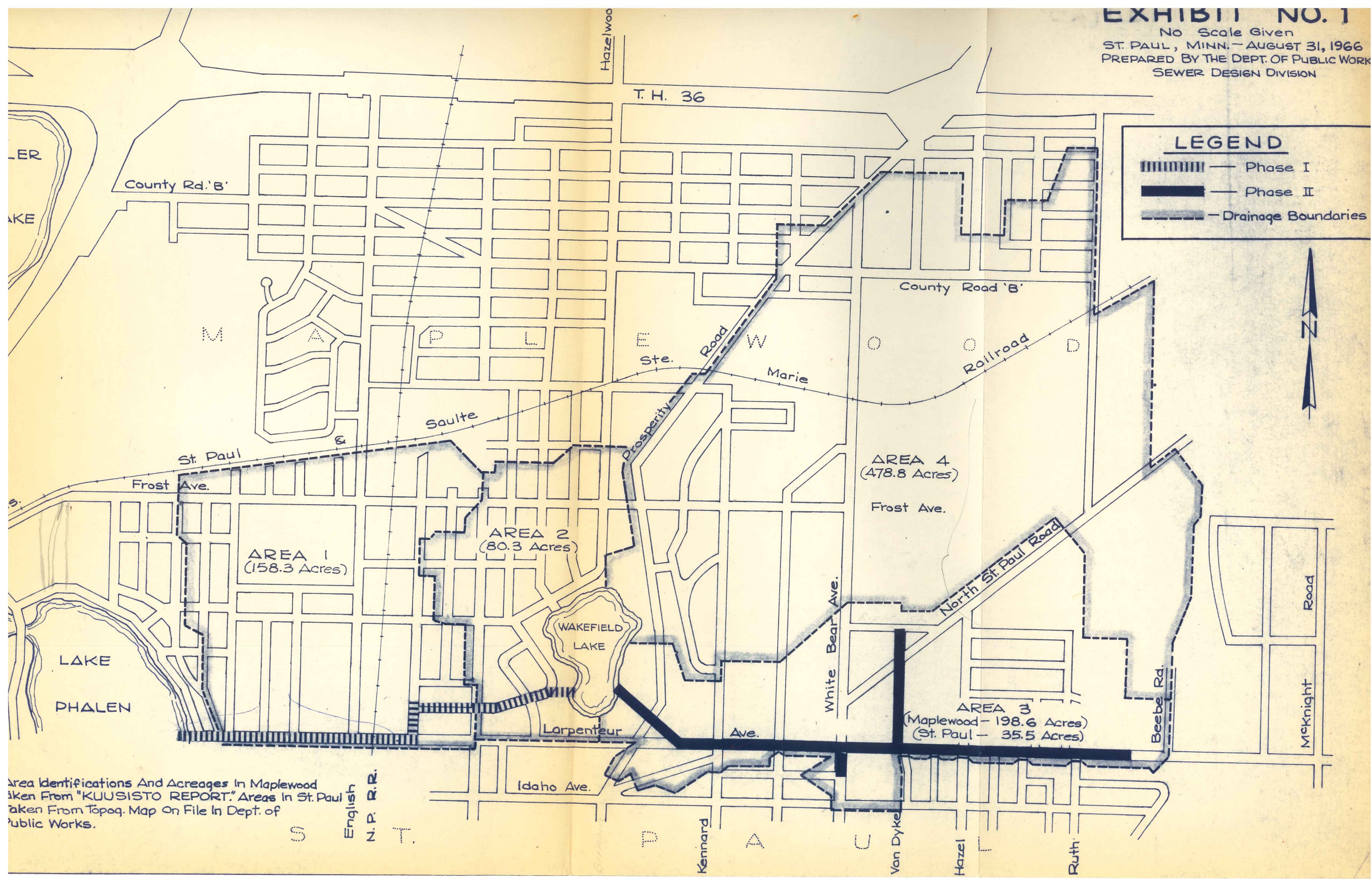
