The City of Saint Paul, Department of Safety and Inspections has inspected the above referenced property on **August 7, 2025**, and has determined that the following deficiencies exist in violation of the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

1. SPLC 34.08 (2). - **DRAINAGE**: Please re-direct your drainage away from the public sidewalk/street. Your current direction is causing a nuisance, and you are not authorized to have discharge to any street, sidewalk, alley, or right-of-way. This interferes or renders dangerous for passage on the public sidewalk, street, or alley. You may contact Public Works at 651-266-6128 for an encroachment permit if needed.

PLEASE REDIRECT YOUR POP-UP DRAIN TO THE CENTER OF YOUR PROPERTY TO PREVENT DRAINAGE ONTO THE PUBLIC SIDEWALK.

You are hereby notified to correct these deficiencies in accordance with the appropriate codes. The enforcement Officer will re-inspect these premises on or after **Sept 3, 2025**, by which date the violations noted must be corrected. Failure to correct these deficiencies may result in an abatement and /or additional fees for re-inspection.

You may file an appeal to this notice by contacting the City Clerk's Office at (651) 266-8585. Any appeal must be made in writing within 10 days of the date of this notice. (You must submit a copy of this Notice when you appeal and pay a filing fee.)

If you have any questions or request additional information concerning this matter, please contact Inspector Hector Caballero, at (651) 266-9158. To arrange an appointment or request an extension of time to complete repairs, you will need to speak directly to the inspector.
