My name is Jacquelyn James and I am a resident of Ward 4 in Saint Anthony Park.

I am writing to express my desire that the council vote **NO** on extending the grant term for ForwardEdge ASIC. I have three reasons for wishing for the grant extension to be denied.

First, I am not comfortable with a company operating in my neighborhood which designs and creates chips used in the world's deadliest warplanes.

Second, they have not complied with the terms in the grant. They did not hire 113 FT positions by December 31st, 2025. I do not want my tax dollars continuing to subsidize a business that does not do comply with the grant objectives.

Finally, one of the grant objectives was to get more people commuting into Saint Paul to work. There are rarely many cars parked at the ForwardEdge ASIC's building when I drive by during business hours. I would rather have a company (or companies) using that space who require their workers to come into the office more often. That way, our local businesses like Lulu's Salsas, Pho 79, Colossal Cafe, and the Finnish Bistro would get more business when these commuters go out to lunch.

Dear St. Paul City Council,

My name is Laichia Vang and I am currently a resident of St. Paul, MN, and I urge you to vote against the grant extension for ForwardEdge ASIC, located at 2344 Energy Park Dr., at the February 4th city council meeting.

ForwardEdge ASIC is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Lockheed Martin, the most profitable weapons manufacturer in the world. They produce semiconductor chips that power the world's deadliest warplanes, the F-35. F-35s are a core tool of the Israeli military in the ongoing genocide of Palestinian people; they are used to indiscriminately bomb people in Gaza, in violation of international law.

As a Hmong-American, my people have been displaced due to the continued investment of weapons, as seen in the Vietnam War and Secret War. Hmong people have roots in Southeastern Asia, particularly within the borders of what are currently the nation states of China, Vietnam, Laos, Thailand, and Myanmar. Hmong people were allies to the United States during the Vietnam War (1955-1975). The Secret War devastated Hmong villages; between 30,000-40,000 Hmong soldiers (some as young as 10) were killed in the conflict, and approximately 50,000 Hmong noncombatants were killed or injured. Many of these weapons were produced by weapons manufacturers like ForwardEdge ASIC and Lockheed Martin. Further, did you know that Lockheed Martin was the company that profited the most during the Vietnam War?

Many Hmong people came to the United States as refugees in the aftermath of the war. St. Paul, Minnesota is currently home to one of the largest Hmong communities in the United States. As City Council, it is your responsibility to ensure that we do not continue to inflict this violence.

Today, as ICE terrorizes our communities with military-grade weapons, it is unconscionable to use our tax dollars to fund a tech company that inflicts the same inhumane mass violence on people abroad. By voting against their grant extension request, you'd require ForwardEdge ASIC to pay back a portion of the \$800,000 forgivable loan, allowing these funds to instead be invested back into our vibrant, resilient Minnesota community.

I look forward to seeing you vote against their extension request on February 4th. Thank you.

Hello. My name is Mary Lawrence, I moved to the Twin Cities in early January, one day before Renee Nicole Good was murdered, one week before carcinogenic nerve gas was deployed on a residential street, nearly asphyxiating an infant as a neighborhood rallied to support and bear witness to the abduction of another neighbor who had been shot while fleeing ICE, and two weeks before the murder of Alex Pretti. In the month that I've lived here, I have witnessed a community in the throes of grief unlike anything I've ever seen up close. People are sick with it. Unable to safely leave their homes for anything, including to access life saving medical care in emergencies, for fear of being abducted or killed by immigration enforcement, immigrant communities in the Twin Cities are frightened for their lives. To use our tax dollars to renew a contract with Lockheed Martin in our own backyards- Lockheed Martin, the arms dealer that makes the destabilization of the nations many of them had to flee a possibility, the corporation that makes the fear, sickness, and death that happens in cities far away but not so different from Minneapolis and St. Paul a certainty, would be the ultimate insult to your constituents. It would be unforgivable, the kind of offense that your names would forever be synonymous with, the kind of betrayal people will take with them to ballot boxes, to the streets in search for justice. To ensure the continued welfare of Lockheed Martin, the company that makes ICE Helicopters, before the welfare of the residents of St. Paul, being hunted by ICE, would be the complete abandonment of the community. There is no good reason to do it whatsoever. We as human beings are blessed with pattern recognition for our own survival, and try as some might to camouflage the patterns of history, people do inevitably see things as they are. I see the terror Lockheed Martin subjects people to internationally, in Gaza and Caracas, to name a few, and now that I have lived in Minneapolis for this past month, I have empirical evidence that we as Americans are not actually so exceptional that this terror won't be used on us also. It's happening now. I urge you to not extend the contract with Lockheed Martin. I urge you to do anything for our benefit at all.
